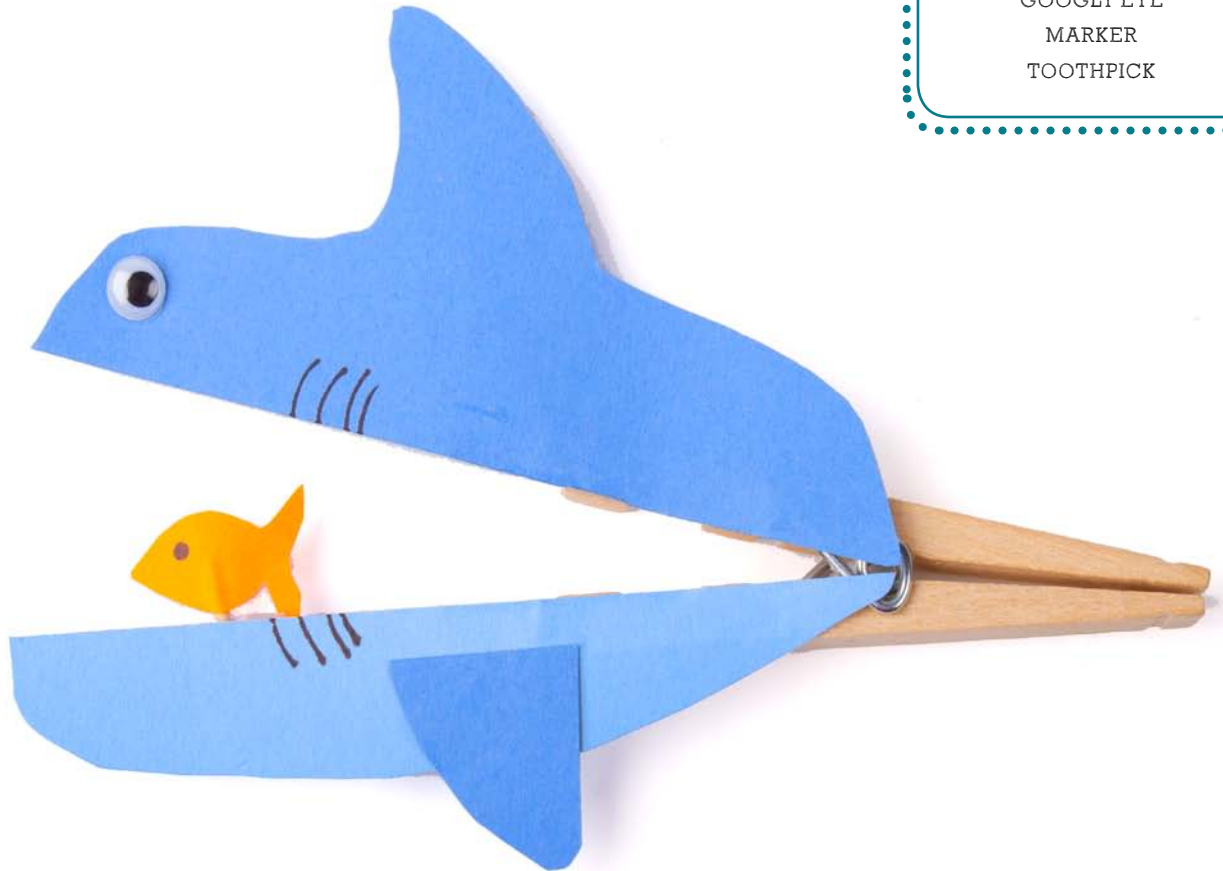


# HUNGRY SHARK

Will the little fish get away?

## MATERIALS:

PLAIN PAPER  
PENCIL  
SPRING CLOTHESPIN  
SCISSORS  
BLUE, LIGHT BLUE,  
AND ORANGE CARD STOCK  
GLUE  
GOOGLY EYE  
MARKER  
TOOTHPICK



- 1** Draw a shark on plain paper. Make it about as long as the clothespin. Cut out the shark. Then cut it in half horizontally. This is your template.
- 2** Trace the top of the shark on blue card stock. Trace the bottom on light blue card stock. Cut out the shapes.
- 3** Cut a fin out of blue card stock. Glue it to the bottom of the shark.
- 4** Glue a googly eye to the top of the shark.
- 5** Draw gill lines with a marker.
- 6** Cut a small fish out of orange card stock. Glue it to a toothpick. Glue the toothpick to the back of the bottom half of the shark.
- 7** Glue each piece of the shark to the clothespin. Leave the handle exposed so you can press it to open the shark's mouth.
